Bob's Fishing Report



HOT HOT HOT! Waiting for some cooler water.

CHAIN O'LAKES: Catfish good on liver or stink bait. BGs spawning again shallow. Other species slow due to hot water.

LAKEFRONT: Big lake trout, some big steelhead and the occasional coho and king in 125-200 fow. Cooler water will bring them in closer. Kings have not arrived at the shore line yet.

DELAVAN: BGs good in 15 feet parallel to the weed line; SM and LM bass on points or in deep

weeds. Small pike are everywhere.

NORTHPOINT / WAUKEGAN: Early morning in 80-140 fow, mixed catches of lakers, kings, steelhead and an occasional coho and brown are being taken. Lots of marks but some days are tough. Opportunities to take some big lakers or kings. Some steelies and lakers out in 160-260 range.

AREA PONDS: BGs are up shallow finishing their spawn. LM good in deep cover.

GENEVA: Smallies were being caught in 20 feet at night with drop-shot rig. During the day drag some suckers or perch on lindy rigs in 30 fow for smallies or pike.

SHABBONA: Steady but slow fishing, best on panfish near shore, water is warm.

KANKAKEE RIVER: Small mouth going on minnows, finesse baits, crankbaits and surface lures. Catfish are even hitting crank baits.

The Special Recreation Association of Central Lake County puts on a fantastic fishing derby for about 80 special needs children every year.
